The process for authenticating your Australian educational documents

1. Visit <https://www.smartraveller.gov.au> to verify that your educational document can be legalised by the **Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade (DFAT)** in Australia.
2. Authenticate your document at the **Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade (DFAT)** in Australia.
